#### c) Wombourne Carnival Committee

Councillor Peace reported he attended the AGM on 10<sup>th</sup> October 2018. Support for this year's carnival had been excellent with over 5000 visitors. There had been no grant from the County Council this year, however, the Committee had still been able to distribute £100 to thirteen local groups, including the six schools who took part in the carnival. Social media would be utilised to give the local community an opportunity to put forward ideas for the theme of the 2019 carnival. All officers were re-elected en bloc.

Councillor Peace reported he attended an informal cheese and wine evening where eleven local groups gave a short presentation about their organisation. 104 local groups had been identified to be included in the local directory which is being compiled. The Chairman, Mrs Marlene Longman, outlined what the Association had to offer such as free equipment loan and small grants. A showcase evening would take place following on the Christmas light switch on, on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2018.
