01/19 APOLOGIES

Apologies were received from Councillors Peace, Miss Roberts, Miss Tait and Tudor.

02/19 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

03/19 MATTERS ARISING FROM THE MINUTES

04/19 PLAY AREAS

Poolhouse Play Area – The Clerk informed Members the benches were made to measure so they would be replaced and the see-saw fixed weather dependent the week beginning 21st February 2019. Councillor Mrs Bond noted the sand under the see-saw needed raking and the weeds removing.

Bratch Park – The Clerk reported unfortunately the wall into Bratch Park had been vandalised with graffiti. She informed Members she had made enquiries into sandblasting on the recommendation of the District Council, but was informed by a local firm this was not needed. She had ordered some graffiti remover and Mr Hayward was going to attempt to remove the graffiti himself. The enquiries into the replacement basketball net, surface of the aerial runway and the internal brushes on the exercise equipment were still outstanding.

The Chairman asked Councillor Upton to inspect the MUGA and report back on the missing bolts, sharp edges and missing caps.
